Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate. We use Makaton in school in the Early Years and KS1, and teach older children the signs as well. Every week we will share with you the sign the children have learnt, so that you can use them at home too.

Educational Psychologist Drop-Ins

We are delighted to be able to offer in person, drop-in sessions with our EP again this year. These will take place on **Monday 30th June**. She will be offering appointments between **9am and 2pm**, and each session is half an hour long. She will be able to talk to you about anything that is impacting on your child's education – it could be something specific like a learning need, or it could be a social or emotional need, for example friendship issues or a family separation.
